Our staff, volunteers, partners, donors, and sponsors adapted quickly to unexpected change, holding virtual CASA Volunteer Info Sessions and trainings, hearings via web conferencing, virtual "Interrupting Racism for Children" Workshops, socially distanced and safe gift card drives in place of a toy drive, and a year-end fundraiser that broke records as our donors hearts grew bigger, not smaller, rising to meet the challenges of our time.

And we, too, will overcome any challenges because **our children need us.** Perhaps, now more than ever. We will always raise our voices to keep them safe, to represent their best interests in court, and to dismantle disparities so that no child's race predicts their life outcomes.

For years, Child Advocates has provided contracted attorneys to youth with specific legal needs. We created a new program that offers legal representation to children in the child welfare system, known as the **Direct Representation Program**, which works cohesively alongside the existing GAL/CASA network to provide comprehensive legal representation to all youth in need of legal services.



## Event Highlights



### Virtual Trivia Night

With the help of individual donors and corporate sponsors, we raised over

**\$50,000**

which directly supported our community's youth through best-interest advocacy.

### Summercation Kids Fair

Child Advocates, Choices, the Children's Bureau, and the Indiana Department of Child Services came together to host a drive-through **Summercation Kids Fair**.

Thanks to a generous grant from **Lessonly**, we raised **\$24,329** and offered prepackaged school supplies/hygiene kits to **600** children!



### Year End Appeal

Child Advocates set a goal of raising **\$40,000** for the **2020 End of Year Campaign**.

Together, we surpassed this goal and raised **\$51,395.69** to support children experiencing abuse and/or neglect.

### Gift CARD Drive

We raised money to purchase gift cards to brighten the 2020 holidays for over **187** children.





## Helping Kavon Shine, a Success Story

It is no secret that 2020 was plagued with many challenges that have touched the lives of people across the globe. However, through all of the stress and hardships that the community has endured together, one must not forget to celebrate the good moments.

**For the Fairbotham family, this moment was the official adoption of their now 14-year-old foster son, Kavon.**

## The Fairbothams' Journey Towards Adoption

Kavon first walked into Derek and Joseph Fairbotham's lives as a shy third-grade student at McKinley Middle School in need of academic and behavioral support. As a special education teacher at McKinley, Joseph immediately went out of his way to assist Kavon in any way that he could, with Derek by his side matching his instinct to help.

**Their connection was instant and only grew over the next two years** while Kavon lived with a temporary foster placement and continued to attend school at McKinley. "I always had a connection with him," Joseph laughed. "I always told everybody that I thought he was like a son, even though he was not my son yet."

During the middle of his fifth-grade year, Kavon ran into complications with his foster placement. Kavon was removed from McKinley and temporarily placed in another home. Because of this, Derek and Joseph decided to make the necessary arrangements to become adoptive foster parents.



Despite this distance, Derek and Joseph remained confident that Kavon's needs were being met thanks to the constant support of Child Advocates.

"In every meeting Child Advocates always wanted the best for Kavon," Joseph said. "This continued as he was transitioned into our house."

**Through every step of his journey, Child Advocates accompanied Kavon and ensured he felt heard, supported, and cared for.** The Fairbothams never

lost hope that everything would work out for the best in the end. After several long weeks, the couple's prayers were answered with one simple phone call.

"Finally one day, Kavon's caseworker called and said, Guess what? His foster placement fell through. Are you and Derek ready for a foster child?"

Without hesitation, the couple accepted. By the end of 2018, Kavon had found himself in the Fairbothams' loving, safe, and supportive foster home with the hopes of adoption sitting just beyond the horizon.

By August of 2020, the Fairbothams' adoption of Kavon was finalized and what Joseph knew to be true all along was official; **they were finally a family.**

"I knew it was always supposed to happen. My mom and dad had heard stories and my friends all knew how excited I was about him," Joseph said. "In my heart, I just always knew."



"Child Advocates means giving children a voice and being their advocate both in court and out of it. 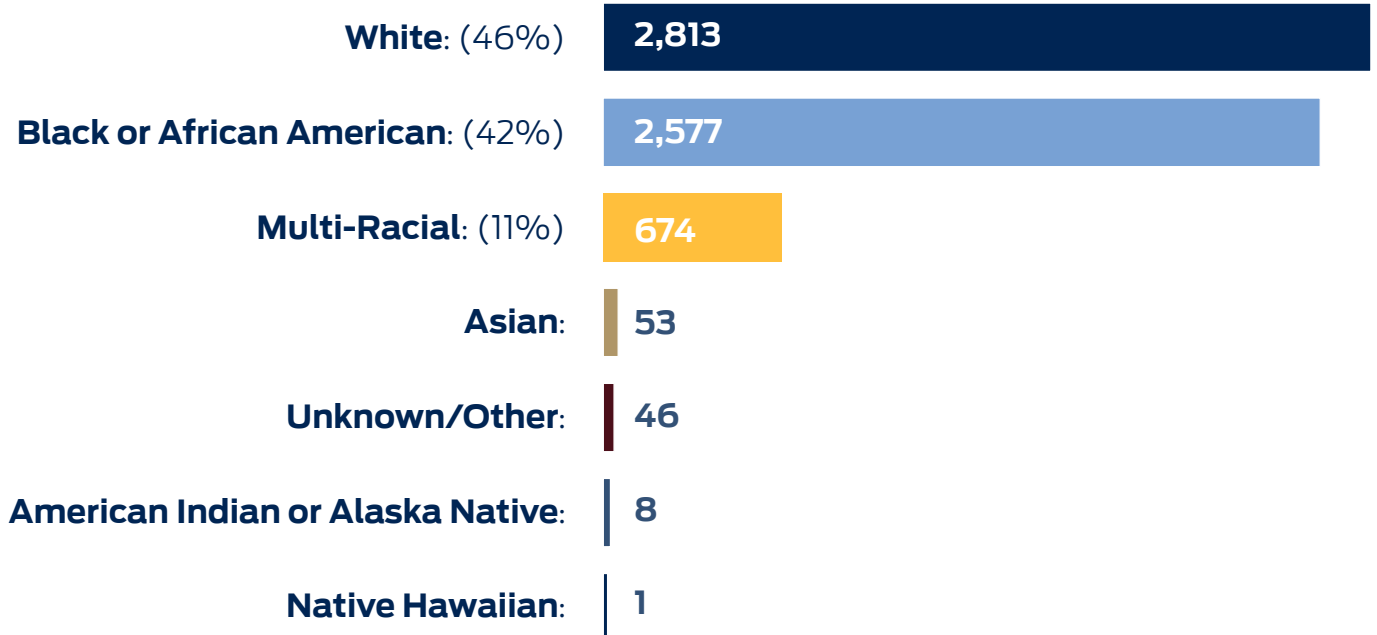

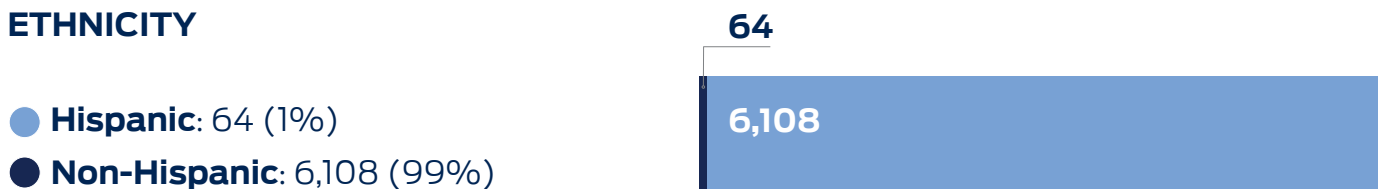

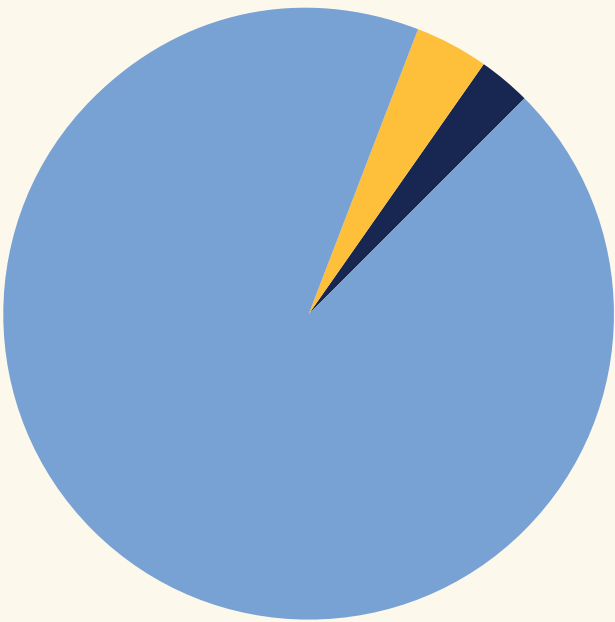
# 2020 Financials
